



PART-TIME CLINICIAN

The Domestic Violence Center of Howard County is a non-profit agency offering innovative and comprehensive services to victims of domestic violence, child abuse, and sexual assault. The agency, in partnership with the Howard County Child Advocacy Center, invites applications for the position of part-time Clinician. This is a grant-funded position, 25 hours per week. The DVC offers competitive pay, a supportive work environment, paid vacation and sick leave, and a 403(b) plan.

Primary Responsibilities:

The selected individual will provide emergency mental health services, counseling, and mental health assessments to determine the therapeutic needs of child abuse victims, and will serve as a support group facilitator for victims and their family members.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate will have a LCSW-C or LCPC and a minimum of three years experience working with victims of child abuse. A thorough background investigation is required.
