Jacquelyn Campbell, PhD, RN is a Professor in the Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing. Dr. Campbell has published more than 320 articles, seven books and been PI of more than 15 major NIH, CDC, NIJ, DOD and DOJ grants in her decades of advocacy policy work collaborating with domestic violence survivors, advocates, health care professionals and marginalized communities. She is particularly known for her research on domestic violence homicide and the development and validation of the Danger Assessment (DA) that helps IPV survivors more accurately assess their risk of being killed or almost killed by their abusive partner that is used widely in the US and globally.
