



Delegate Bartlett joined the General Assembly in 2019 and has since served on the House Judiciary Committee, quickly ascending to Vice Chair in 5 years. She's the House Chair for the Joint Committee of Legislative Ethics and sits on the Anne Arundel County's Video Lottery Council and Sexual Assault Evidence Kit Funding and Policy Committee under the Maryland Attorney General.
